# 2018/2019 COMMUNITY IMPACT

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## **OUR PROGRAMS**



## ADULT LITERACY

The **Adult Literacy** program offers tutoring and high school equivalency preparation for English-speaking adults. In the past year, 57% of students who attended at least 50 instructional hours showed improvement as measured by federally-approved posttests. Among those students, 75% improved by a full grade level and 42% improved by more than one grade level.

# ENGLISH FOR SPEAKERS OF OTHER LANGUAGES



The **English for Speakers of Other Languages** program provides English language tutoring and citizenship exam preparation for adults. In FY 2018-19, 83% of ESOL students who attended at least 50 instructional hours showed improvement as measured by federally-approved post-tests. 72% of those students improved by at least one grade level. Thirteen students passed the US Naturalization Exam and became citizens.



## YOUTH LITERACY

The **Youth Literacy** program focuses on children who struggle with reading and spelling. Most have learning differences and all are from low-income homes. In the past year, 90% of students improved a full grade level on standardized post-tests.

# DOLLY PARTON'S IMAGINATION LIBRARY

**Dolly Parton's Imagination Library** is a free program that delivers a new, specially selected, age-appropriate book mailed directly to a child's home each month until their fifth birthday. In this program year, we had 2,068 children enrolled in the program who are learning to love to read!

## IN TOTAL

The Literacy Council served 299 students through the work of 232 volunteer tutors, who contributed a total of 14,749 hours of instruction which has an audited cash value of \$407,793. Combined with the outreach of the Imagination Library, we reached a total of 2,367 people.




