This internship creates an opportunity to make a positive impact on the youth in your community while gaining professional development experience for yourself.

Internships with Literacy Together will take place at after-school sites in the Asheville community. Tutors will receive \$15/hour* (\$16 for current college students OR high school students with documented tutoring experience) to support middle school students with reading comprehension, literacy and math during the school year, Tuesday -Thursday each week. All applicants are required to complete online tutor training.

Upon completing your application, we will contact you for an in-person or virtual interview.
