1.	Visual Quick Drill (2 min.) Drill pack & burlap.
	Tell me the name of the letter and the sound it makes.
	Trace it on the burlap with 2 fingers.
	If it's a vowel, tell me the key word and show the hand signal.
2.	Review/Introduce Concepts for Reading (5 min.) Magnet board, Lesson Notebook (if needed).
	I'm going to make a word. Swoop under it as you read. (Encourage tap and smear if needed.) (3-4 review words)
	If new concept: Introduce new letter, syllable type, spelling rule, etc., and enter in Lesson Notebook. (3-4 new words)
3.	Word Cards (3 min.). Word cards, stopwatch.
	Pick a card, read the word, lay it on the table. Encourage tap and smear if needed. After all are read, have student read the words 2 more times. Timing is optional; encourage speed and accuracy. (5-8 words, mostly new concept words)
4.	Word List (5 min.) Wilson Student Reader page, chart & marker (if 1.3 or higher).
	Let's practice a few words. Point to 2-3 words in one list for child to read. Show the list of 15 words for charting.
	Now read each word to yourself before you read it out loud. The first thing you say
	COUNTS. After charting, student reads list 2 more times. Timing is optional; encourage speed & accuracy.
5.	Sentence Reading (5 min.) Wilson Student Reader page
	1. Read the sentence to yourself. Track the words with your finger.
	2. Now read it out loud.
	3. Tutor reads the same sentence to model fluency.
	4. Now you read it again. Do these 4 steps for each sentence, one at a time. Ask comprehension questions.
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6.	Auditory Quick Drill (1 min.) Magnet board.
	I'm going to say a sound. You <u>repeat</u> the sound and <u>point</u> to the letter that makes the sound.
7.	Review/Introduce Concepts for Spelling (5 min.) Magnet board, Lesson Notebook (if entry). I'm going to say a word. You repeat the word and spell it on the magnet board. Encourage tap and smear if needed.
	Now swoop and read the word.
	Tutor covers the word. <i>Spell</i>
	2-3 review words:
	3-4 new words:
8.	Written Work (11 min.) Dictation sheet, pencil, 2 colored markers for tic tac toe, sight word cards.
	For each sound, word, and sentence dictated, the student should <i>repeat</i> what you say <i>before</i> writing.

	Check for capitalization, punctuation, and spelling. Student re-reads sentences. Check comprehension.
9.	Controlled Reading (8 min.) Story or book: Student reads story aloud in small sections. Stop and discuss. Ask child to paraphrase in their own words.
	Ask comprehension questions. Tutor reads same section, then student re-reads. At end of story, talk about it. Goal is active, engaged reading!
